

Organ Donation Day

Under the aegis of the Government of India, the state government has launched a program for spreading the awareness about organ donation. MIMER Medical College, Talegaon had participated in the program with 2 rallies on 30th August 2016 departing from the institution. One of the rallies went to Indrayani college and the other was held till Jijamata square Talegaon.



Street-plays were conducted by the medical students and interns. The rallies were attended by the Medical Superintendent of the BSTRH Dr. More and Deputy Superintendent Dr. Waghmare.
