ORDER

Subject:- Renewal of permission for admission of 5th Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 at Maharashtra Institute of Medical Education & Research, Talegaon, Pune for the academic year 2018-19-Regarding.

Whereas, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India vide order No.U-12012/20/2018-ME.I dated 31.05.2018 directed Maharashtra Institute of Medical Education & Research, Talegaon, Pune not to admit 5th batch of MBBS students for the academic year 2018-19 against the increased intake from 100-150;

2. Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 09.07.2018 in Writ Petition (C) No.662 of 2018 and 735 of 2018 directed as under:-

Writ Petition (C) No.662 of 2018

"...6. In view of the facts and circumstances of this case, we are of the considered opinion that without going into the competence of the MCI in conducting the second inspection after invoking Regulation 8(3)(1)(c), the Petitioner-College is entitled for enhancement of intake from 60 to 100 seats for the fourth batch of MBBS course for the academic year 2018-2019. It is not in dispute that the Petitioner-College has rectified the defects pointed out by the MCI in its first inspection prior to 30.05.2018.

..... The first Respondent is directed to grant permission to the Petitioner-College for enhancement of the intake of students from 60 to 100 for the academic year 2018-2019."

Writ Petition (c) No.735 of 2018

"...Except for the fact that the renewal for the enhanced intake of 100 seats is for the third MBBS Course, this Writ Petition is similar to Writ Petition No.662 of 2018. Therefore, the Government of India is directed to enhance the intake of the Petitioner-College from 50 to 100 for third MBBS course for the academic year 2018-2019.

We are also informed that there are five other colleges who are similarly situated to the Petitioner-Colleges in Writ Petition (C) No. 662 of 2018 and 735 of 2018 which are as follows:

We direct the Respondent-Union of India to examine whether the five Colleges mentioned above are similarly situated to the Petitioners in Writ Petition No.662 of 2018 and 735 of 2018 and to extend the benefit of enhanced intake to them also."

3. Whereas, in compliance with the above direction of the Supreme Court the matter has been examined and it has been felt that the above College is also similarly situated to the Petitioners in the above writ petitions and is required to be extended the same benefit;
4. Now, therefore, permission of the Central Government under Section 10 A of IMC Act, 1956 for admission of 5th Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 for the academic year 2018-19 at Maharashtra Institute of Medical Education & Research, Talegaon, Pune is conveyed herewith;
5. The next batch of students in 2019-20 against increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 will be admitted only after obtaining permission from the Central Government;
6. Admissions made in violation of above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be taken as per provisions of IMC Act, 1956 & the Regulations made thereunder;
